

Dr. Gary Lange Presented at the Korean Racing Authority's UCan Center Conference in Seoul, South Korea from August 22-24, 2009.



Gary Lange Ph.D., MFT, NCGC presented at the Korean Racing Authority's UCan International Gambling conference in Seoul, South Korea August 22-24. His case presentation entitled "Never a Dull Moment: Treating a Gambling and Amphetamine Addict" highlighted the case of a female gambler who was also addicted to diet pills and now has over 3 years clean of drugs and gambling. The UCan Gambling Addiction Treatment program is funded by the Korean Racing Authority and has been operating for ten years free of charge to local Koreans. Dr. Lange, representing the U.S. was joined by presenters from Canada, New Zealand as well as other Korean specialists.

While in Asia, Dr. Lange also went to Japan and met with several addiction and gambling treatment programs. His presentation entitled "Strategies for Treating Problem Gamblers" was at the One-Day Port program in Yokohama. This residential program for male gamblers is directed by a very dedicated Tsutomu Nakamura, who was eager to learn about other strategies and exercises to use with their recovering gamblers. The Japanese GA and GamAnon meetings he attended were very 12 step focused.
